



DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

ADAM WILSON #93,626
(the “Regulated Member”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(“CARNA”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Regulated Member and CARNA, dated with effect **October 13, 2020**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a Disciplinary Agreement with CARNA, ADAM WILSON #93,626 (the “Member”), acknowledged and admitted that his behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Member’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to CARNA include the following:

- The Regulated Member, while in the role of Patient Care Manager, failed to respond appropriately to a LPN’s complaint of non-consensual touching by a patient, specifically that the LPN was motorboated.
- The Regulated Member, while in the role of Patient Care Manager, failed to disclose a personal relationship with a LPN that created a conflict of interest.
- The Regulated Member failed to uphold confidentiality when he inappropriately disclosed confidential information to a LPN with whom he had a personal relationship.

The Member agreed to complete course work, write a paper and his employer(s) will provide two (2) practice report letters covering a total six (6) months of nursing hours. Conditions shall appear on the CARNA register and on the Member’s practice permit.
