



DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

BRENDA SANCHE, #80,493
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(“**CARNA**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and CARNA, dated with effect **SEPTEMBER 8, 2021**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with CARNA, BRENDA SANCHE, #80,493 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to CARNA and includes the following:

- The Registrant failed to adequately document their care of an elderly patient after the patient was admitted to the ER and while they were the patient’s primary nurse.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework and education, complete a behaviour improvement plan and pay a fine. Conditions shall appear on the CARNA register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
